

RESOLUTION No. 522

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 16, 1948

AMERICAN RIVER FOLSOM DAM

RESOLVED, that Honorable Peter E. Mitchell, member of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to represent said City Council and to appear before the House Sub-Committee on Appropriations at Washington, D.C., and there to speak on behalf of and to present the resolution of this Council approving and memorializing Congress to appropriate funds to construct the Folsom Dam Project for the purpose of preventing the further vast wastage of water from the American River and to conserve and impound the year-found run-off of the watershed of said stream and its several tributaries for the urgent needs of irrigation, reclamation, flood-control, domestic and commercial water supplies, hydro-electric energy and recreation in Central California.
