Commending Judge Alice Lytle

WHEREAS, the city of Sacramento supports youth initiatives as one of seven city-wide priorities; and

WHEREAS, Judge Alice Lytle is a life-long supporter of youth initiatives and providing positive alternatives for youth in our community; and
