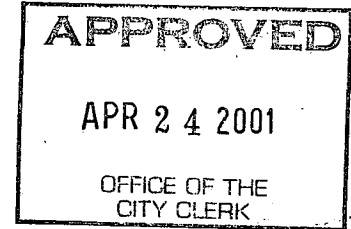

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

This project is located on Ehrhardt Avenue between Franklin Boulevard and Center Parkway, Council District 7. See attached location map, Exhibit 1.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council accept the low bid from North Star Construction for an amount not to exceed \$127,615 and award the contract.

SUMMARY:

Bids were received from seven (7) contractors and opened by the City Clerk on April 4, 2001. The low bidder was North Star Construction, with a bid of \$127,615. North Star Construction met the Emerging and Small Business Enterprise (ESBE) goals. It is therefore proposed to award the contract to North Star Construction for \$127,615.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This project is part of the FY 2000-2001 Capital Improvement Program, proposing to replace deteriorated and undersized drain inlets and drain pipe.

Bids were received from five (5) contractors, as follows:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$132,000. The estimated completion date is July 6, 2001

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The total estimated cost including design, construction, inspection and administration is \$165,000, based on the bid of \$127,615. There is sufficient funding in the project budget to award and complete the project.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that this project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15302 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This action is consistent with Title 3, Section 3.60 of the City Code concerning award of contracts.

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:

This project included participation goals of 20% for emerging and small business enterprises as required by Ordinance 99-007 and Resolution 99-055, relating to ESBD participation goals and policies, adopted by the City Council on February 9, 1999. The responsive low bidder, North Star Construction exceeded the ESBE goals with a participation level of 98.04%.



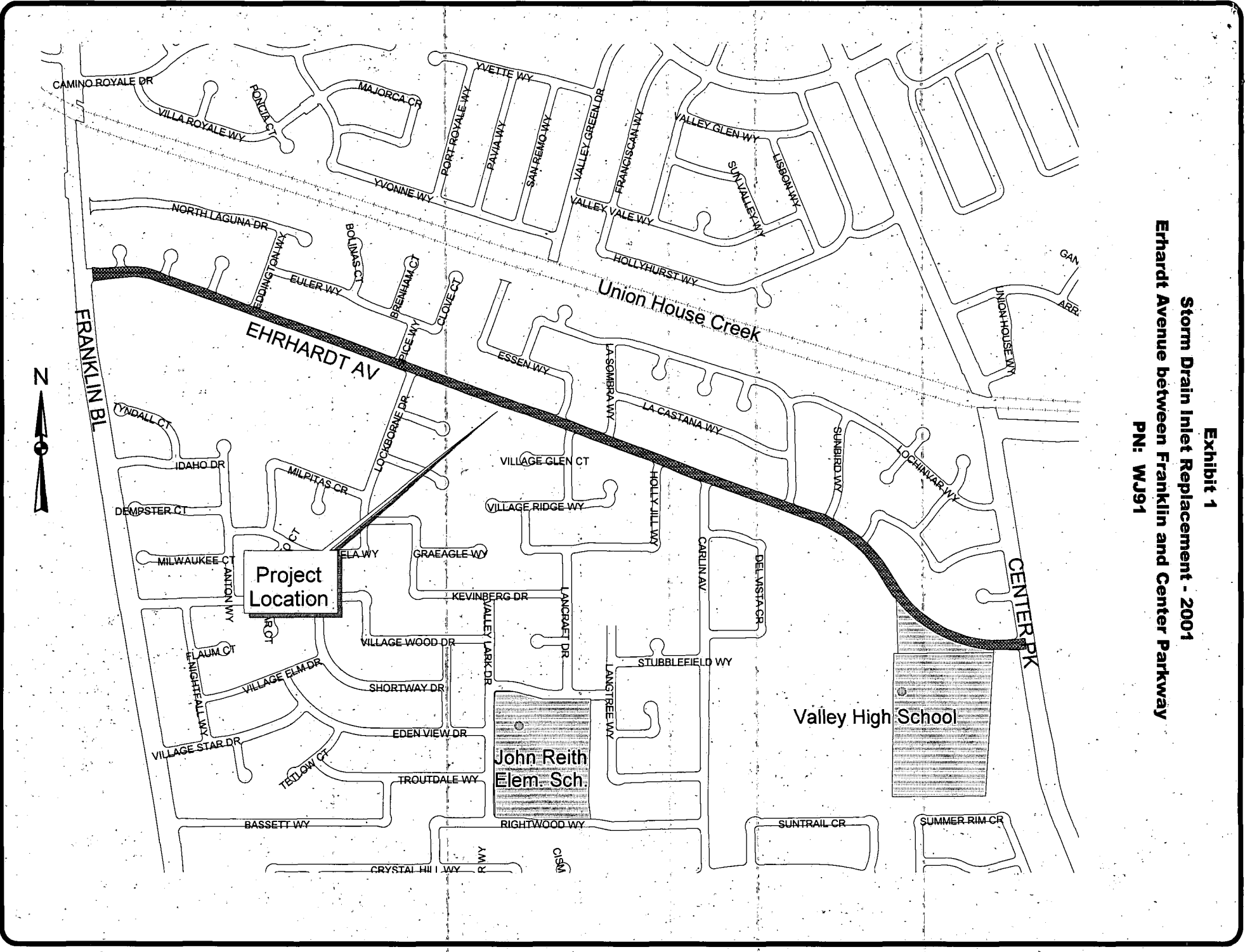
