

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-102

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 26, 2008

APPROVE FUNDING FOR THE RIVER DISTRICT SPECIFIC PLAN PROJECT

BACKGROUND

- A. The Richards Boulevard Area Plan (RBAP), adopted in 1993 as a community plan for the River District, contains many outdated assumptions and needs to be updated to result in a vibrant urban corridor linking the River District with Downtown and the Railyards.
- B. In Resolution 2007-915, the City Council directed staff to proceed with an update to the RBAP.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to increase the Individual Project Agreement with the Redevelopment Agency to fund consultant services for the River District Specific Plan in the amount of \$200,000.
- Section 2. Staff is authorized to increase the revenue and expense budget of the Richards Boulevard Capital Improvement Project (CIP #B18216500) in the amount of \$200,000 for the creation of a River District Specific Plan and related documents.
