

RESOLUTION No. 134

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

January 31st, 1929

A RESOLUTION CREATING THE DEPARTMENT OF HOTELS AND PROVIDING FOR RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING SAME.

WHEREAS, Sacramento City has been operating certain property, known as the "ST. FRANCIS HOTEL" and operating certain property at SAYLES FLAT for hotel accommodations of such of its citizens as visit there; and

WHEREAS, it appears that, for the better administration of said properties, a department therefor should be created,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That there is hereby created a department to be known as the "DEPARTMENT OF HOTELS", which, under the direction of the City Manager, shall be charged with the administration of all hotel, restaurant and lodging accommodations which are or shall be furnished by said City of Sacramento.

That the Department of Hotels shall be under the direct charge of a Superintendent, and said superintendent shall have such assistants and employees as shall be necessary for the proper conduct of said department, to be determined by the City Manager upon recommendations of the said Superintendent, with the approval of the City Council. Salaries of said Superintendent and assistants and employees shall be in accordance with the budget for 1929 adopted by the City Council with reference to the operation of said properties.

That rates for and time of use of the accommodations furnished shall be such as are now in effect or such as shall be fixed by the City Manager, with approval of the City Council.
