**SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF BID AND CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE 1999/2000 SPEED HUMPS PROJECT (PN: SH89)**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Accept the bid of Florez Paving in the amount of \$139,963.34
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the 1999/2000 Speed Humps Project (PN: SH89).

**SUMMARY:**

This project will construct asphaltic concrete speed humps on various City streets in all Council Districts. The scope of this project involves minor alterations to existing public structures, primarily residential streets, within the City of Sacramento.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The purpose of the project is to reduce vehicular speeds within residential areas to improve livability and pedestrian safety.

- This project was authorized in the 1999/2000 Capital Improvement Program.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on November 17, 1999 and are summarized below:

- The construction estimate was \$158,000.
- Award to Florez Paving is recommended.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

- The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design, construction and engineering costs is \$185,000.
- The project budget for the 1999/2000 Speed Humps Project is \$200,000.
- As of November 18, 1999, the unobligated Measure A Sales Tax Fund 201 balance is \$247,000. These funds are sufficient for award.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, the Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the proposed project. As a result, it was determined that the proposed project will not have any significant adverse impact on the environment and a Categorical Exemption has been prepared in accordance with section 15301(c). The Notice of Exemption will be filed with the County Clerk after Council approval.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

**ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:**

To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to 8 plan rooms and construction service organizations for publication. All are directly involved with ESBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available ESBE firms to participate in the bid process. Project notices were sent to 30 organizations involved in ESBE recruitment. The project was also announced on the Project Information Line and on the City's Internet site at [www.sacto.org/bids](http://www.sacto.org/bids).
