

RESOLUTION No. 721

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, AND DETERMINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the public interest and necessity require the acquisition by said City of Sacramento of certain real property herein described for street purposes;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, FOUND, AND DETERMINED that the said property hereinafter described is necessary for such purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, FOUND AND DETERMINED that the City Attorney be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to commence proceedings in eminent domain to acquire said property for said purpose.

The property herein found necessary to be taken is described as all that real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California described as:

The east 25 feet of that certain 10.23 acre tract of land conveyed by Frank P. Williams and Anna E. Williams to Sacramento City School District of Sacramento County by deed dated August 8, 1927, and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County in Book 138 of Official Records at page 487, more particularly described as follows:

A strip of land of a uniform width of 25 feet measured westerly at right angles from the following described east boundary of said 10.23 acre tract: beginning at a steel rod monument set out on the south line of Fifth Avenue of the City of Sacramento from which a granite monument set at the intersection of the center-line of Fifth Avenue with the center-line of 65th Street (said monument being 20.0 feet west of the quarter-corner common to Sections 15 and 16, Township 8 North, Range 5 East, M.D.B. & M.) bears North $0^{\circ} 17' 50''$ East 21.50 feet and thence North $89^{\circ} 51'$ East 2136.25 feet; thence from said point of beginning South $0^{\circ} 17' 50''$ West 844.95 feet to the northeast corner of that certain tract of land conveyed by George A. Brock to Lizzie Brock by deed dated May 24, 1935, and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County in Book 502 of Official Records at page 426.
