

Resolution of Award No. 3179

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 15th day of November 1956, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the ~~work~~ work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

at the prices specified in his proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of

**the Alley in the Block between I and J Streets
from the Easterly line of 28th Street to the

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 3179, passed and adopted by said City Council on **October 11th** 1956, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.
