

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2728

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, public interest and convenience require that the work and improvement hereinafter described, in the City of Sacramento, State of California, should be done;

NOW, THEREFORE, the said City Council of the City of Sacramento ~~does~~ hereby resolve and declare that it is the intention of the said City Council to order the following work and improvement to be done in said City, to-wit:

TO CLOSE, VACATE, and ABANDON the Alley between Q Street and R Street from the easterly line of 21st Street to the westerly line of 22nd Street, reserving however, the right of entry to repair, maintain, and construct, sewer, water, and gas pipes and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities, now in place in said Alley or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid closing are to be taken subject to such reservations and exceptions.

And said City Council does hereby determine and declare that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary benefit, and will affect and benefit the lands and District hereinafter described, and which said District is hereby declared to be the District affected and benefited by said work and improvement and that therefore the entire damages, costs, and expenses of said work and improvement shall be and are hereby made chargeable against and shall be Assessed upon said lands and district, which District is within the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and the exterior boundaries of the land affected and benefited by said work and improvement


are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Bounded on the North by Q Street;
on the South by R Street,
on the West by 21st Street,
on the East by 22nd Street.


And the City Council does hereby elect to proceed to do said work under the provisions of Division 9, Part 3, "STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941", being an Act of Legislature of the State of California, Approved May 13, 1941; and hereby fixes the 17th day of December, 1948 at 8:00 o'clock P.M., in the City Council Chamber in the Sacramento City Hall on I. Street, between 9th and 10th Streets of said City, as the time and place when and where any and all persons interested in said work and improvement may appear before the said City Council of said City and be heard by said City Council upon such appeal, and show cause, if any they have, why the said improvement should not be made.

The SACRAMENTO UNION is hereby designated as the daily newspaper published and circulated in said City, in which this RESOLUTION SHALL BE PUBLISHED; and the Superintendent of Streets is hereby directed to post notice of the passage of this RESOLUTION in the manner prescribed by Law.
