

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0007

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 8, 2019

Approving Park Naming of McKinley Village Park Site ES3 as Russ Solomon Park And Park Site ES4 as Ricardo Favela Park

BACKGROUND

- A. McKinley Village Park Site ES3 is a 0.68-acre neighborhood park located in the East Sacramento Community Plan Area.
- B. McKinley Village Park Site ES4 is a 0.13-acre pocket park located in the East Sacramento Community Plan Area.
- C. On December 6, 2018, the Parks and Recreation Commission considered and supported the recommended naming of McKinley Village Park Site ES3 as Russ Solomon Park and Park Site ES4 as Ricardo Favela Park.
- D. Russ Solomon was a legendary Sacramento resident who founded Tower Records and built it into a global music and cultural phenomenon.
- E. Ricardo Favela was a professor of art at California State University Sacramento, an accomplished artist, and a founder of the renowned artists collective, the Royal Chicano Air Force.
- F. Naming the McKinley Village park sites after Russ Solomon and Ricardo Favela is consistent with the City Council's Facility Naming Policy adopted on February 26, 2008 (Resolution 2008-112).

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The park name for the McKinley Village Park Site ES3 as "Russ Solomon Park" and is hereby approved.
- Section 2. The park name for the McKinley Village Park Site ES4 as "Ricardo Favela Park" and is hereby approved.
