

RESOLUTION NO 140

RESOLUTION DIRECTING AN INVESTIGATION OF THE OFFICIAL ACTS AND CONDUCT OF H. A. KLUEGEL, CITY MANAGER AND THE APPOINTMENT OF A COMMITTEE THEREFOR:

WHEREAS, it is freely circulated upon the streets of the City of Sacramento that H. A. Kluegel should not be retained as City Manager of said City by reason of incompetence, misfeasance and neglect of duty in the position of City Manager, which he has held for the last four months, in this: that he has proven himself unable to handle the matters and affairs of the office of City Manager with proper dispatch and judgment; that he has undertaken to install a system of record keeping in the Police Department which entailed an expense of \$2463.90 without consulting the Council as to its policy in the expenditure of said money, and in violation of the City Charter; that said system is found to be impractical and in addition would require the time and attention of several officers and would compel their removal from the streets where they would be better employed in preventing crime and traffic violations and accident; that he has neglected during his tenure of office to inform himself of the business and affairs of the City of Sacramento and is therefore unable to intelligently and without undue delay, inform the Council on matters coming to its attention when requested so to do.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, that the Mayor appoint a committee of five members to make an investigation of these charges and to report to this Council.
