RESOLUTION APPROVING LEASING WHARVES TO THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANK AS FISCAL AGENT OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City of Sacramento lease to The Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, as Fiscal Agent of the United States Government, for a period of three months, at a rental of \$1,350.00, the wharves on the waterfront commonly known as the Sacramento Navigation Company wharf and the "P" Street wharf.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That said Bank be, and it is hereby, given options to renew said lease for three additional periods of three months each at the same rental.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby, authorized and directed to make, execute, and deliver such lease and options.
