Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 27th day of August 1948, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **A. TEICHERT & SON, INC.,**

at the prices specified in **its** proposal for said work now on file.


The work herein referred to is ~~the improvement of~~ the installation of a Storm Sewer in East Sandburg Drive from the Easterly line of Orchard Terrace Unit No. 2 (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) to the center line of Moddison Avenue; Moddison Avenue from the center line of East Sandburg Drive to the center line of South Sandburg Drive; Right-of-Way, owned by the City of Sacramento, as contained in Deed dated April 15th, 1948, Recorded May 3rd, 1948 in Book No. 1484 of Official Records, Instrument No. 18690, as deeded by Louis D. Carlson and Ada H. Carlson, his wife, and John Sandburg and Minnie E. Sandburg, his wife, to the City of Sacramento, (a municipal corporation),

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2714, passed and adopted by said City Council on July 16th 1948, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the **Sacramento Union** a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
