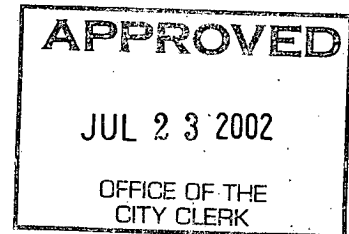

**SUBJECT: Naming of City of Sacramento Parking Facilities**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:** Districts 1 and 2

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends the City Council approve by resolution, naming City Garages to reflect their general location or associated landmark.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends naming the City Parking Facilities in accordance with the City of Sacramento's policy for naming City sites and facilities. The Parking Facilities have traditionally been referred to by various letters of the alphabet (i.e. Lot A, Lot C, etc.)

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Following the guidelines set forth by the City's Policy for Naming City Facilities adopted on November 27, 2001, garage names were selected to represent the location of the garages. As per City policy, the recommended garage names represent "a distinct geographic, environmental or developmental feature". In addition to having a relationship to an adjacent identifying feature, the new names should also aid the public in finding and remembering the garage locations. Following is a list of recommended names. Exhibit A lists the current designation and street location, the identifying landmark features, and the alternative names which were considered.

City staff developed the list of proposed names. Stakeholders from the Area 1 Neighborhood Services Department Citizens Leadership Group, Old Sacramento Management, and Westfield Shopping Town have reviewed the proposed names. Several of their comments were incorporated in the recommendations; a few suggested alternative names were added to the list, and overall the stakeholders were supportive of the proposed names.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The designation of the Parking Facilities does not have an immediate financial impact. Basic signage will be added to the entrance areas with funds available in the existing Painting and Signage CIP Budget. Individual facility signage will be developed over the next few years.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

None


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

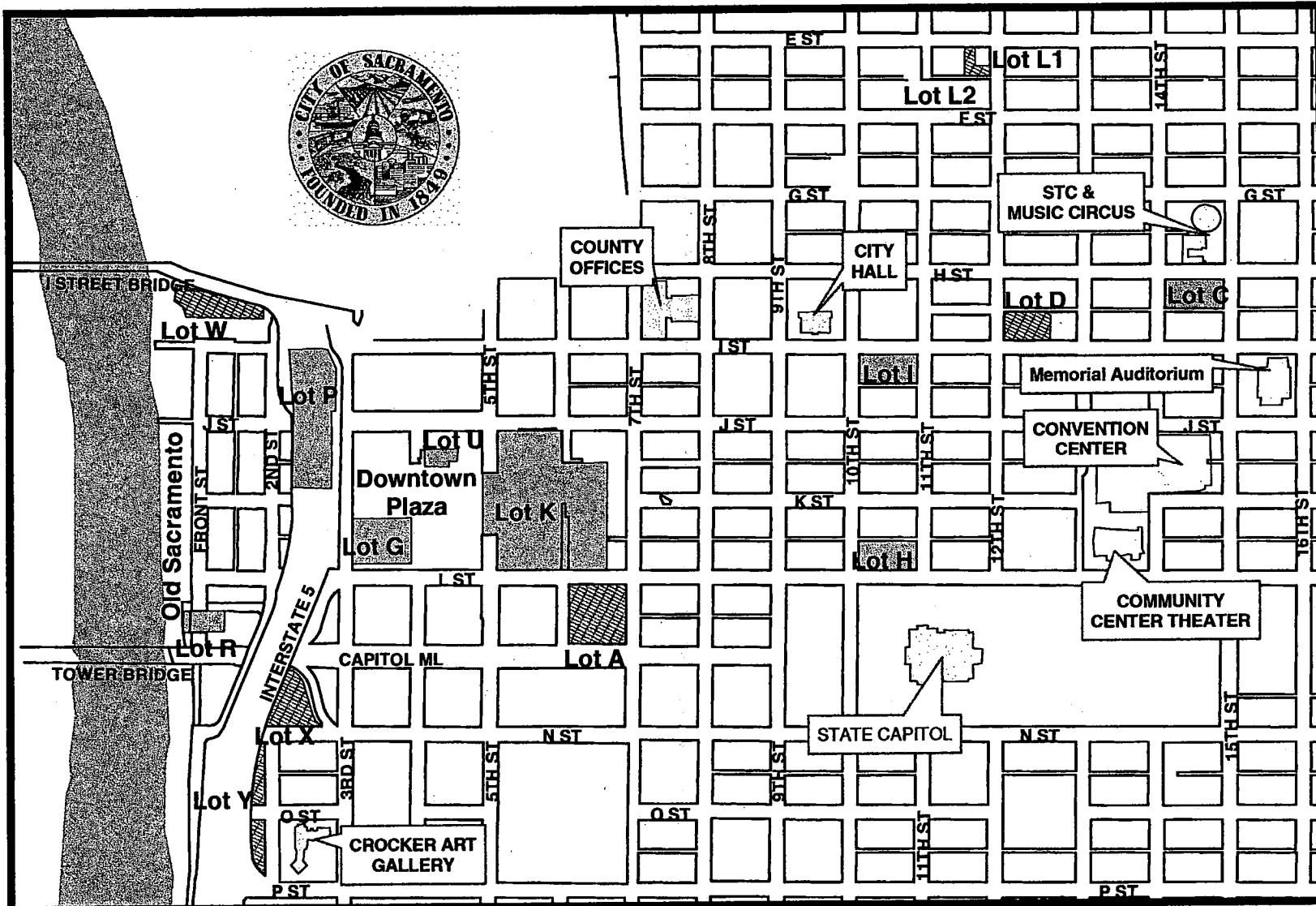

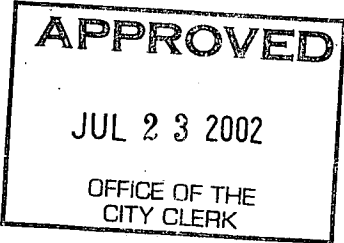

**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO'S CRITERIA AND GUIDELINES FOR ALLOCATING SACRAMENTO COUNTY REGIONAL SANITATION DISTRICT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TREATMENT CAPACITY BANK CREDITS FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2001, City Council authorized the City Manager to sign a Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) to initiate City participation in the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District Economic Development Treatment Capacity Bank (CC2001-177).

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento's Economic Development Department has had a year by which to monitor and review the Economic Development Bank program and recommends the program guidelines be amended.

- 1. The City's Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District (SRCSD) Economic Development Treatment Capacity Bank Credits Program has been established for the purpose of promoting and implementing the City's strategic plan and adopted economic development strategy. The program offers identified projects the opportunity to purchase required ESD's at a substantial discount.
- 2. Approval is given for the City Manager to be authorized to review projects and forward them to City Council for final approval if they meet the following amended criteria and guidelines:
  - A. A prospective project must meet at least one of the following criteria:
    - 1. Projects in redevelopment, CDBG and/or infill development areas.
    - 2. Projects located in neighborhood commercial corridors identified in the adopted City Economic Development Strategy.
    - 3. Projects located at a targeted key development opportunity site identified in the adopted City Economic Development Strategy

4. Projects that create additional employment
  5. Catalyst projects such as restaurants or high job creation projects that will further economic development.
- B. Projects falling under any of the following criteria may be disqualified from receiving credits from the Economic Development Treatment Capacity Bank:
1. Projects where the applicant is changing locations within the City of Sacramento without creating any new job opportunities.
  2. Projects that will be owned and/or operated by a jurisdiction that is a member of the Economic Development Treatment Capacity Bank.
  3. Projects that are relocating from a neighboring jurisdiction that is a member of the Economic Development Treatment Capacity Bank.
  4. Projects that add more undesirable uses to an already saturated area (undesirable uses defined in an Urban Master Plan, Streetscape Plan or Special Planning District).
