of the City Council

National Homeownership Week June 3-10, 2000

WHEREAS, homeownership strengthens families, stabilizes neighborhoods, builds communities, and promotes personal well-being; and

WHEREAS, homeownership fosters economic prosperity for families and communities and generates economic growth; and

WHEREAS, Sacramento Partners in Homeownership is actively engaged in increasing homeownership opportunities for the people of Sacramento, and is doing so through the successful efforts of a partnership of public, private and non-profit organizations including the City of Sacramento, the County of Sacramento, Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency, US Department of Housing and Urban Development, Sacramento Association of Realtors, Building Industry Association of Superior California, Sacramento Neighborhood Housing Services, Sacramento Home Loan Counseling Center, Freddie Mac, California Housing Finance Agency, and many local non-profit housing corporations including Habitat for Humanity, Nehemiah Progressive Housing Corporation and Rural California Housing Corporation; and

WHEREAS, Sacramento Partners in Homeownership would like to highlight the following events in conjunction with National Homeownership Week: *Independence at Mather* with 381 affordable homes in this significant new community; *Capital Park Homes Groundbreaking Celebration* for 64 new single family homes; and *Del Paso Nuevo*, the first phase of building a 154-acre "new town in town"; and

WHEREAS, Sacramento Partners in Homeownership is an active affiliate of the National Homeownership Strategy and the National Partners in Homeownership, which seeks to increase the national homeownership rate to an all-time high of 67.5% by the end of the year 2000.

NOW; THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby proclaim June 3-10, 2000 to be *Homeownership Week* and the day of June 6th to be *Homeownership Day*, and do hereby call upon the people of Sacramento to recognize this special observance with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
