Attached is a tabulation of sealed proposals received by the City Clerk for furnishing equipment in accordance with specifications adopted by the City Council.



### MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Recommendation Award Of Proposal #332 For One (1) 36 Cubic Yard Front Loading Truck Mounted Refuse Compactor

We have reviewed per your request the proposed bid on Proposal #332 for one (1) 36 cubic yard front loading truck mounted refuse compactor. During the course of this review, we contacted Mr. Reggie Young and requested that he supply us with his weekly cost for not having the additional front loader available.

Attached you will find his response to this request. The request indicates in the 240 working day proposal of International, which is low bid, the cost in overtime to the City would be \$9,894. In addition to this overtime cost, there is an additional expense for shop overtime which we cannot compute but would estimate to be a substantial amount. This is due to the fact that we are currently operating with a minimal amount of this type of equipment. The difference between International's proposal of \$83,160.39 and the alternate proposal by T & J Garage for a 41 cubic yard truck at \$89,523.10 is \$6,362.71. The delivery time on the unit from T & J Garage's alternate proposal would be forty-five (45) calendar days. The net savings to the City, if award is made to T & J Garage, would be \$3,531.29. Therefore, considering the facts surrounding this proposal, it is our recommendation that the award be made to T & J Garage for their alternate proposal with delivery not to exceed forty-five (45) days.

### MEMORANDUM:

TO: R. J. Brookins, Equipment Maintenance Superintendent

FROM: R. Young, Waste Removal Superintendent

SUBJECT: Waste Removal Penalty Related to lack of a New Front Loader Refuse Packer

In compliance with your request the Waste Removal Division provides the following information regards the subject refuse packer:

1. Under normal conditions it costs the Waste Removal Division \$128/week for each week that we do not have a front load refuse packer to implement our third route.


The Division has a budget for 3 Sanitation Workers III. We can not hire the third employee until we get a truck for him to use. Currently we are paying two employees \$493 per week in overtime to complete our routes in lieu of paying \$365/week in regular time to the third employee.

2. In the last 30 days, we have experienced increased maintenance downtime on our existing front load refuse packer. This downtime (which is presumed to be related to excess vehicle use) has resulted in an additional \$110/week in overtime expenditure.
3. The added maintenance downtime has prevented our crews from meeting some of their collection schedules. While the frustrations associated with failure to collect on time is great, we can not quantify it. However some examples include;
  - (1) Our failure to collect the Arden Area Burger King before 7:00a.m. results in cars blocking our access to the waste containers, and thus we either make several trips to the facility or worse ask customers to come out and move vehicles.
  - (2) Our failure to collect the Convention Center before 8:00p.m. results in other delivery trucks blocking access to the waste compactor, again requiring a search for vehicle owners prior to collection or leaving the compactors.
