**SUBJECT: EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT--EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR
HUMAN RIGHTS/FAIR HOUSING COMMISSION**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board and the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Chairperson and Mayor, respectively, to sign the attached employment contract with Barbara Lehman as the Executive Director of the Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission in the name of the Commission.

DISCUSSION

Pursuant to an amendment to the Joint Powers Agreement between Sacramento County and the City of Sacramento, approved on December 14, 1993, by both bodies, the Executive Director is appointed by the Board of Supervisors and the City Council following receipt of recommendations by the County Executive and City Manager.

A screening panel consisting of the County's Personnel Services Administrator, the City's Human Resources Director, and a community member, reviewed 17 applications and selected seven candidates for interview. An oral board consisting of three Human Rights/Fair Housing Commission Commissioners interviewed and ranked these seven candidates. The County Executive and City Manager interviewed the top three candidates for the position.


