**SUMMARY:**

In November 2000 the Crocker Art Museum Association (CAMA) and the City of Sacramento selected Gwathmey Siegel & Associates Architects (GSAA) to develop a Master Plan for the Crocker Art Museum that would help realize the institution's vision to create a world-class museum facility that will generate a high level of excitement, complement its surroundings, offer a meaningful museum experience, and be an integral component of the greater Sacramento region's cultural and economic life.

The goal of the Master Plan study was to create an architectural program for the Museum to meet current needs as well as perceived needs for the next 15 years and to create massing concepts that would lead to the selection of a preferred footprint for any new construction.
