APPENDIX

Persons holding the following positions shall make investment and real property disclosures, personal income disclosure, business entity income disclosures, and business position disclosures, as required and in a manner prescribed by this Code for the type of real property, businesses, as described in the applicable disclosure categories.

ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE HOUSING AUTHORITY
OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO FOR 1987

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The budget dated November 17, 1986, is hereby approved as the Budget of the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento for the 1987 calendar year.

Section 2. New budget positions or classifications in the Budget are hereby approved subject to classification review by the Executive Director.

Section 3. Unspent appropriations relating to capital improvements projects in progress at December 31, 1986, are carried forward in the calendar year 1987.

Section 4. As to the items contained in Section G of the Budget, the Capital Improvements Program, and those items only, the budgeted amount for any item therein may be amended by majority vote of the Governing Body of the entity or entities actually undertaking the improvement. Such an amendment so enacted shall be deemed to have been effected by all of the entities originally establishing the budget without further action by those entities not directly involved in the expenditure of the funds in question.

Section 5. The Executive Director is authorized to submit the Annual Housing Operating Budgets for 1987 to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
