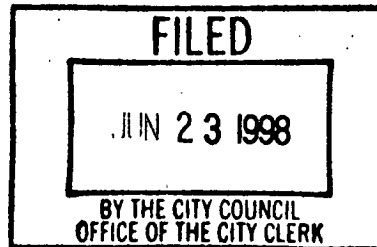

**SUMMARY:**

✓ This is an informational report in response to Councilmembers' request regarding angle parking. A comprehensive approach to this request will be undertaken over the next sixty days with a report back by late August.

**BACKGROUND:**

During the budget hearings on June 16, Councilmembers Cohn and Yee expressed interest in additional angle parking in the central city area. Public Works staff will work with Council Offices in response to specific project requests and identify their feasibility, costs and funding alternatives. Within sixty days, staff anticipates developing a comprehensive plan proposal to implement angle parking in the central city area.

CEQA does not apply to this issue at this time.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**


