RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THOMAS P. KENNY

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Thomas P. Kenny on the twenty third day of May, at the age of sixty (60), in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Thomas P. Kenny was a well-known and respected member of the Sacramento community whose exemplary efforts and accomplishments were of great value to the citizens and the City of Sacramento; and,

WHEREAS, since 1970 Thomas P. Kenny served with dedication and distinction as the Executive Secretary of the Sacramento Area Central Labor Council AFL-CIO, which represents 80,000 workers in 90 unions in Sacramento, Yolo, Placer, Amador, El Dorado, and Nevada Counties; and,

WHEREAS, Thomas P. Kenny will be remembered as a humanist and a tireless advocate for worker rights, as well as an outstanding musician; and,

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Thomas P. Kenny, and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Thomas P. Kenny.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to his bereaved family, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
