

RESOLUTION No. 68

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of


July 19th, 1928.

WHEREAS, that certain deed dated the 18th day of July, 1928 by and between George A. Burns and Sarah Burns of the City of Sacramento, conveying to the City of Sacramento for street and highway purposes the following described property, to-wit:


"BEGINNING at a point on the line common to the lands now or formerly owned by W. R. O'Brien, and the lands now or formerly owned by G. A. Burns, whence the southwesterly corner of the said lands now or formerly owned by G. A. Burns bears South $33^{\circ} 50'$ East 64.26 feet; thence from the point of beginning North $33^{\circ} 50'$ West along the said common line 163.13 feet; thence North $74^{\circ} 23'$ East 240.08 feet to a point on the line common to the lands now or formerly owned by G. A. Burns, and the lands now or formerly owned by G. A. Meister; thence South $33^{\circ} 58'$ East along the said common line 241.13 feet to the southeasterly corner of the lands now or formerly owned by G. A. Burns; thence South $77^{\circ} 49\frac{1}{2}'$ West along the line common to the said lands now or formerly owned by G. A. Burns and Terrace Villa Subdivision (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California) 42.44 feet; thence following a curve to the left of a radius of 179.00 feet, whose chord bears North $20^{\circ} 52'$ West 81.21 feet; thence North $33^{\circ} 58'$ West 88.12 feet; thence following a curve to the left of a radius of twenty (20) feet, whose chord bears North $69^{\circ} 47'$ West 23.41 feet; thence South $74^{\circ} 23'$ West 153.91 feet; thence following a curve to the left of a radius of twenty (20) feet whose chord bears South $20^{\circ} 16\frac{1}{2}'$ West 32.41 feet; thence following a curve to the right of a radius of 221.00 feet, whose chord bears South $19^{\circ} 24'$ East 78.79 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 18,700.92 square feet, more or less."

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council that foregoing deed be and the same is hereby accepted, the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said deed and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder."
