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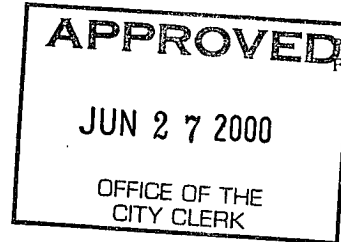

**SUBJECT: STOCKTON BOULEVARD STREETScape (PN:TU72) - APPROVAL OF
ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$121,700 WITH
THE HLA GROUP**

COUNCIL DISTRICT AND LOCATION:

Stockton Boulevard – Fruitridge Road to El Paraiso Avenue, Council District 6.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

Authorize the City Manager to execute the attached Consultant Services Agreement in the amount of \$121,700 with The HLA Group for engineering services for the Stockton Boulevard Streetscape Project.

SUMMARY:

This report requests that the City Council authorize and direct the City Manager to execute a Consultant Services Agreement with The HLA Group in the amount of \$121,700 for engineering services for the Stockton Boulevard Streetscape Project.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION: None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

City staff is recommending to sole source this agreement. The HLA Group has been the designer for the Stockton Boulevard Master Plan. With the studies and survey work already performed, they are the ideal source to design the Stockton Boulevard Streetscape Project.

The HLA group has assembled a highly qualified and experienced team to perform the engineering services needed for the project.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The approval of the consultant services agreement for engineering services is not considered a project as defined by Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act guidelines. The activity involves no physical construction and has no potential to cause a significant impact on the environment.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

CDBG funds in the amount of \$200,000 are being transferred into project TU72, which is sufficient for award.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:
