

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-602

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

August 21, 2007

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A
SOLE SOURCE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE
COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$278,500**

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Transportation has a need for temporary administrative and technical support, and the use of student interns provides flexibility in meeting service demand levels.
- B. A Request for Qualifications (RFQ) was advertised June 2007, and CCF was the only qualified firm to respond. The department has had multiple contracts with CCF over the past five years and the student intern program administered by CCF continues to be a cost-effective means of obtaining temporary administrative and technical support.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY
COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a professional services agreement with the Community College Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$278,500.


