SUBJECT: Mack Road FAU Project - Approval of Program Supplement No. 1 to the Local Agency-State Agreement No. 03-5002

SUMMARY

Construction of the Mack Road FAU project was completed in October 1978. Project funding was provided by City (20%) and Federal Highway (80%) funds. Approval of Program Supplement No. 1 to the Local Agency-State Agreement for this project is recommended.

BACKGROUND

Construction of the Mack Road FAU project was completed in October 1978. The project consisted of improving Mack Road from Franklin Boulevard to State Route 99 and on Center Parkway from the south fork of Elder Creek to Mack Road. Improvements included widening of the existing roadway, construction of a bridge and traffic signals. Project funding consisted of a combination of City (20%) funds and Federal Highway (80%) funds. Engineering design required for preparation of plans, specifications, and estimate was performed by the City of Sacramento; construction inspection and construction administration was performed by the State of California.

Although construction of this project was completed in October 1978, a federal audit of project expenses verifying allowable expenses has just been completed. This audit determined that expenses incurred by the State during the construction management portion of the project exceeded allowable federal participation by an amount of \$16,960. Thus, reimbursement of Federal Highway funds is required. Since the non-allowable charges were attributable to work performed by the State, they have volunteered funding for the \$16,960 required. By execution of Program Supplement No.

City Council  
Mack Road FAU Project (JN:N/A)  
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1 of the Local Agency-State Agreement, the State will fund the overrun in construction engineering at no cost to the City of Sacramento.

FINANCIAL

The required matching funds of \$16,960 will be totally funded by the State of California at no cost to the City.


RECOMMENDATION
