SUBJECT: Development of the Southern Extension of Seymour Park (PN:LA81) -
Project Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project is Phase I of the development of the southern extension of Seymour Park beyond Florin Road. The project will consist of clearing the site, grading to provide drainage, installation of an automatic irrigation system and the landscaping of the area.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on March 5, 1987. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$108,000.

FINANCIAL


Additional funds may be needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$145,000. The current budget is \$114,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Quimby Act Funds. The final budgetary recommendation will be made following receipt of bids.

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RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on April 14, 1987.
