

RESOLUTION No. 868

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 4, 1949

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation, did heretofore, on October 6, 1949, acquire title, by condemnation proceedings, to the hereinafter described property; and

WHEREAS, this property is to be used by the City for public purposes, to-wit: A Park; and

WHEREAS, under and pursuant to the provisions of Sub-section (e) of Section 4986 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, said city is entitled to have any liens for taxes thereon canceled;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the taxes on the following property for the year 1949-50 be, and the same are, hereby canceled, and the Assessor is ordered and directed to delete such property from the rolls as property subject to assessment under the provisions of the Revenue and Taxation Code.

That said property is described as all that real property situate in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, described as follows to-wit:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the mesne low water line on the East bank of the Sacramento River with the North line of Parcel No. 2 as described in the Decree Quieting Title dated July 6, 1923, entered in the action entitled Harry L. Huston, Executor of the Last Will and Testament of Ella T. Merkeley, Deceased, Plaintiff vs William K. Weston, et al, Defendants, Suit No. 42485 in the Superior Court of the State of California, in and for the County of Sacramento, a certified copy of which decree was recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, October 21, 1933 in Book 450 of Official Records, at page 89; thence, along the North boundary of Parcel No. 2 as described in said decree North 79° 45' East 633.04 feet to the point of intersection of said North line with a line parallel to and distant Westerly 20 feet (measured at right angles) from the center line of the track of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company's Walnut Grove Branch; thence, parallel to and distant

Westerly (measured at right angles) 20 feet from the center line of said track, Northerly to the Northeast corner of that certain 9.212 acre tract of land shown on the "Plat of Survey of Cowell Property", recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County January 11, 1927, in Book 3 of Surveys, Map No. 4; thence, along the North boundary of said 9.212 acre tract of land, South 79° 45' West 1005.90 feet to a point on the low water line of the Sacramento River; thence, along the low water line of the Sacramento River and following the meanderings thereof, South 47° 07' East 590.18 feet to the point of commencement, containing 9.212 acres, more or less.
