

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 3628

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, public interest and convenience require the abandonment and vacating of excess street right of way on Stockton Boulevard, hereinafter described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby declares its intention to abandon and vacate the following described excess street right of way:

All that real property described as follows:
Beginning at the Northwest property corner of Lot 278 of Wright & Kimbrough Addition No. 14, said plat of which was recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County on May 3, 1906; thence from said point of beginning South $26^{\circ} 19'$ West 7.02 feet; thence South $37^{\circ} 22'$ East 50.67 feet; thence North $89^{\circ} 50'$ East 7.71 feet to the Southwest property corner of said Lot 278; thence along the Westerly property line of said Lot 278 North $36^{\circ} 56'$ West 58.43 feet to the point of beginning, containing an area of 339.48 square feet.

Said excess street right of way is shown on a Plat on file in the office of the Clerk of the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the 6th day of December, 1962, at the hour of 7:45 o'clock p. m., in the Council Chamber of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets, in said City, be, and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the hearing of the proposed abandonment of said excess street right of way.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be directed to publish Notice of Hearing of the proposed abandonment of said excess street right of way in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law, and that said Notice be posted along said excess street right of way to be abandoned, in accordance

with the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, Sections
8300 to 8324, Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.
