

# RESOLUTION No. 580

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, the California Central Valleys Flood Control Association has been organized to represent approximately 450,000 acres of land affected by the Sacramento river and its tributaries in an endeavor to secure adequate appropriations from the State and Federal governments to continue the building and maintenance of flood control works, and

WHEREAS, the present co-operative agreement under which these works are being constructed by the State and Federal governments is about to expire and new legislation is necessary in order to secure money for the continuance thereof, and

WHEREAS, the United States Army Engineers in the Sacramento district are now practically without funds and unless something is done in the very near future, the Sacramento office will be closed, and


WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento is vitally interested in the building and maintenance of flood control works,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City of Sacramento contribute to said California Central Valleys Flood Control Association its membership fee, which has been set at the sum of \$500.00,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Controller be authorized and directed to make such payment to said association.
