**Appropriate Funding for the 4<sup>th</sup> “R” Deferred Maintenance Program**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. The Department of Youth, Parks, & Community Enrichment’s 4<sup>th</sup> “R” child care program has provided a consistently high quality and valuable service since 1986. Child care services are provided before, during and after school hours. throughout the year. The program serves more than 2,000 children each year on 19 elementary school campuses.
  
- B. The 4<sup>th</sup> “R” program has city-owned portables that are in need of repair. Establishing and funding a capital improvement program is necessary to make repairs for the safety of children and employees, the well-being of the program, compliance with licensing, and longevity of the buildings.
  
- C. The 4<sup>th</sup> “R” child care program is a fee-based, self-sufficient program. No General Fund dollars are used in the delivery or administration of the program. Funding of the deferred maintenance program will come from the 4<sup>th</sup> “R” fund balance contingency.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The transfer of \$350,000 from the 4<sup>th</sup> R (fund 6012) available fund balance to the 4<sup>th</sup> “R” Deferred Maintenance Program (L19803500) is approved.
