**APPROVING THE TIME EXTENSION FOR RESOLUTION NO.
2004-631, THE VACATION OF "T" STREET BETWEEN
INTERSTATE 5 AND 3RD STREET WITHIN COUNCIL
DISTRICT 4 VACATION PROCEEDING NO. VP06-04**

BACKGROUND

- A. On August 5, 2004, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2004-631 vacating a portion of "T" Street between Interstate 5 and 3rd Street subject to certain conditions required to be completed within two years of the date of Resolution No. 2004-631.
- B. Resolution No. 2004-631 provides that it shall become void if the conditions of vacation are not completed within two years of the date of Resolution No. 2004-631, August 5, 2006, unless a time extension to complete the conditions is granted by City Council.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. A time extension for completing the conditions of vacation required by Resolution No. 2004-631 is hereby granted and will expire on August 5, 2008.
