

RESOLUTION No. 400

RESOLUTION RESCINDING CERTAIN PORTION OF
RES. ACCEPTING BID NO. 37 ADOPTED 2/18/38

WHEREAS, JOSEPH PEDONE submitted a bid to the City Council for the purchase of Lot 22 "H. J. Goethe Company's Addition 'F' to Sacramento" on February 14, 1938; and

WHEREAS, in the acceptance of the proposal submitted by Joseph Pedone, under Resolution No. 37 adopted February 18, 1938, the Mayor and the City Clerk were directed to execute a deed to said Joseph Pedone; and

WHEREAS, said Joseph Pedone now requests that the deed to said property be made to FREDERICK J. PEDONE, his son;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that that portion of Resolution No. 37 adopted on February 18, 1938, directing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a deed to the said Joseph Pedone be, and the same is, hereby rescinded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are, hereby directed to execute a deed to the said property to FREDERICK J. PEDONE, in accordance with the request submitted to the City Council by Joseph Pedone on October 7, 1938.
