SUBJECT: Provision of Handicapped Transportation Services

The County Executive has been directed by the Board of Supervisors to explore the feasibility of providing transportation for the handicapped through the Sacramento Area Council of Governments and Paratransit Inc.

A conceptual outline of the process is:

- SACOG contracts with City, County and Regional Transit to receive funds and provide handicapped transit.
- Paratransit provides the service through an operating agreement with SACOG.

The Board of Supervisors has stated that it is unable to increase the County contribution to Regional Transit in any form. The County Executive has asked that the City Council respond to two questions:

1. Would the City Council approve of providing handicapped transit through the Sacramento Area Council of Governments?
2. Would the City Council approve of a financing plan that would fix the City and County contributions to transit at current levels?

This matter is being brought to you off the agenda because the County Executive must report back to the Board of Supervisors very quickly and Regional Transit must order vehicles by Monday, June 8, if the concept lister here is unfeasible.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve SACOG as contract administrator for handicapped transit utilizing the current City and County contributions to Regional Transit at current levels.
