**SUBJECT: GRAND AVENUE AND RIO LINDA BOULEVARD TRAFFIC SIGNAL
MODIFICATION PROJECT (PN: SQ01) – APPROVAL OF CHANGE ORDER
NO. 1**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Intersection of Grand Avenue and Rio Linda Boulevard, City Council District 2. (See location map – Attachment A).

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution:

- Authorizing and directing the City Manager to execute Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$42,783 with Shiloh Electric, Inc.; and
- Resetting the City Manager's Change Order Authority.

SUMMARY:

The construction contract to Shiloh Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$152,937 for the Grand Avenue and Rio Linda Boulevard Traffic Signal Modification Project (PN: SQ01) was awarded on June 1, 2004. The improvements included the installation of upgraded traffic signal equipment at the intersection, curb ramps, and a flasher for the southbound direction

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in advance of the signal. Also included in the project was utility replacement, which included a fire hydrant, water valves, and relocation of a drain inlet.

Change Order No. 1 for the Grand Avenue and Rio Linda Boulevard Traffic Signal Modification Project (PN: SQ01), in the amount of \$42,783, will compensate the Contractor for relocating a drain inlet (DI) and level for item quantity increases necessary to complete the project.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION: None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Change Order No. 1 is to compensate the Contractor for the work associated with relocating a drain inlet (a portion of the cost is reimbursed by Department of Utilities); extension of quantities, and for additional construction inspection time to complete the project. The relocation of the DI was necessitated in order to fit a new ADA compliant curb ramp in a limited space.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

As of June 6, 2005, the total unobligated balance for the Grand Avenue and Rio Linda Boulevard Traffic Signal Modification Project (PN: SQ01) is \$49,197, which is sufficient to execute Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$42,783 with Shiloh Electric, Inc.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Development Services Department, Environmental Planning Services has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1, Section 15301(c) and Class 2, Section 15302(c) of the CEQA guidelines. Projects exempted under Class 1, Section 15301(c) consist of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of existing highways, streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use. Projects exempted under Class 2, Section 15302(c) consist of replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems. Due to federal funding requirements, the proposed project was evaluated under National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Guidelines. It has been determined by Caltrans that a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion would satisfy the requirements for NEPA.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This action is consistent with existing City policies regarding transportation, neighborhood revitalization and enhancement and public safety. The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 3, and with the City's Strategic Plan goal for improving the transportation system and enhancing and preserving neighborhoods.

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ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:


DBE project participation requirements were met for the originally approved contract with Shiloh Electric, Inc. ESBD requirements are held in abeyance for federally funded projects.

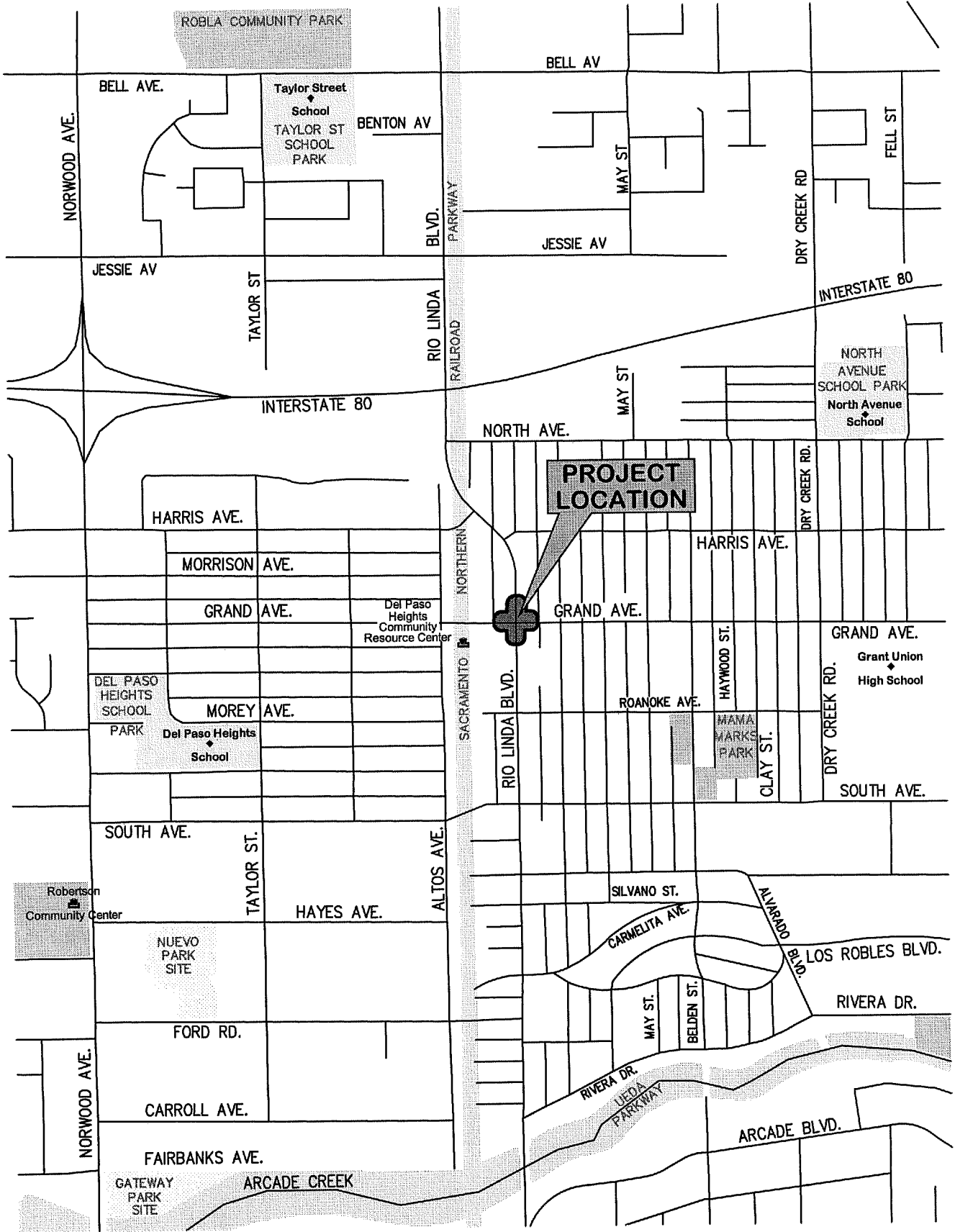

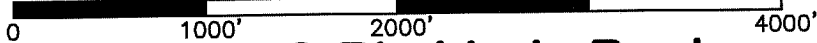
