AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR STREETScape MAINTENANCE SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. The City has an ongoing need maintain the streetscapes along its roadways.
- B. In September, 2008 the City issued Invitation for Bid (IFB) No. B093497016 for streetscape maintenance services and nine bidders responded. East Bay Construction was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, and was awarded the contract. In May of 2009, the contract with East Bay Construction was terminated. With the termination of the City's contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Valley Landscape was determined to be the next lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the formal competitive process.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. A contract is awarded to Valley Landscape for the remainder of the one-year contract for streetscape maintenance services, the original amount of which was \$33,600 in year one, with up to two one-year options for extension. The total amount of the contract, with optional extensions, will not exceed \$120,800 for the three-year period.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute a contract with Valley Landscape for a not-to-exceed amount of \$120,800.


