

# Resolution of Award No. 2740

2740

**Resolved**, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the **10th** day of **June** **1949**, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned; and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **McGillivray Construction Co.**

at the prices specified in **their** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of **54th Street from the Southerly line of V Street to the center line of 2nd Avenue**

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials, and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. **2740**, passed and adopted by said City Council on **April 29th** **1949**, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the **Sacramento Union** a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
