**SUMMARY:**

This project involves the installation of historic street lighting in the Marshall Park area.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The project was authorized by Council on September 25, 2001 as part of the citywide streetlight match program.
- The construction estimate was \$115,200.
- Bids were received and opened on Thursday, June 6, 2002 and contract award to Shiloh Electric is recommended.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The current total project budget is \$275,000. As of June 27, 2002, the unobligated balance is \$268,473.45, which is sufficient to award the contract in the amount of \$108,040.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Neighborhoods, Planning, and Development Services Department, Environmental Services Section, has determined that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 (b) and Section 15303 (d). A notice of Exemption has been filed with the County Recorder's Office.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 3.

To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to ESBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available ESBE firms to participate in the bid process. The recommended contractor includes certified ESBE participation of 70.38%.

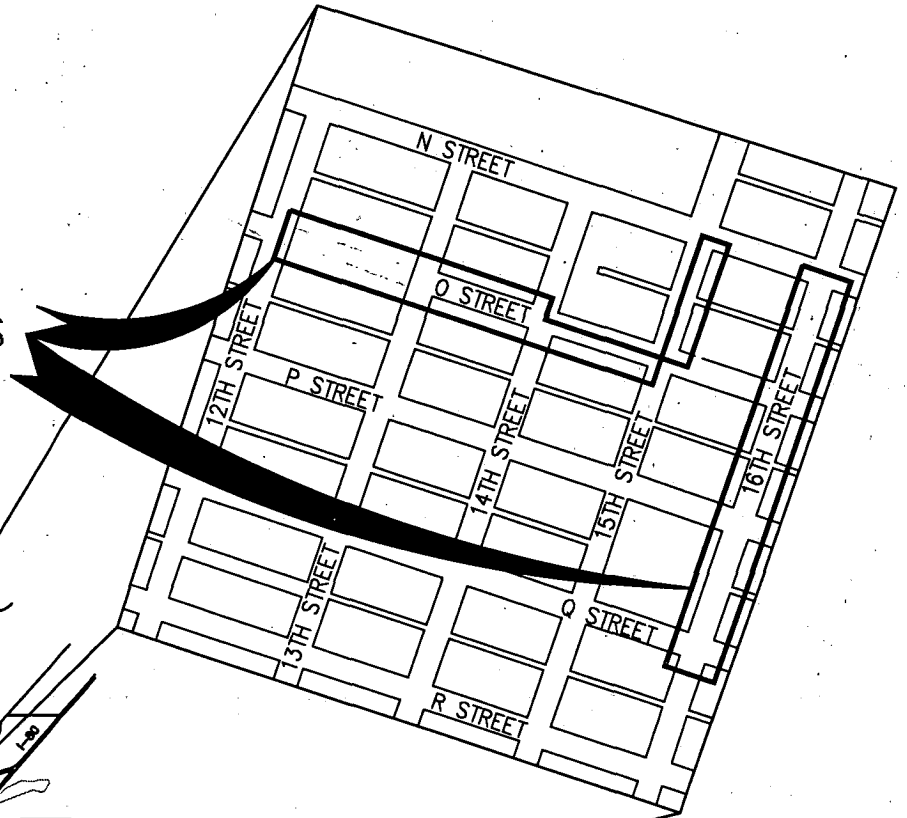

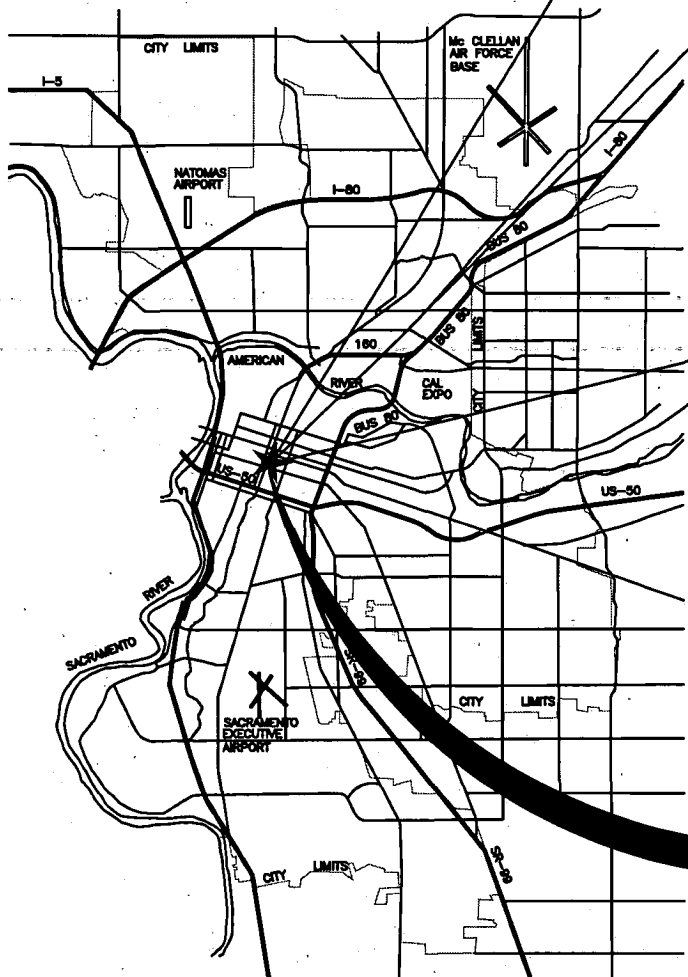
