

RESOLUTION NO. 1356

Adopted by the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento

September 18, 1975

AWARDING PEST CONTROL CONTRACT

WHEREAS, on August 11, 1975, the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento, the Housing Authority of the County of Sacramento, and the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento jointly requested bids for pest control services on Housing Authority residential dwelling units and Redevelopment Agency-owned units to be demolished; and

WHEREAS, on August 25, 1975 bids were received and the low bid submitted by PRO-KILL PEST CONTROL; and

WHEREAS, through excusable error, Pro-Kill Pest Control failed to submit with its bid a Bid Guaranty complying with the provisions of the Instructions to Bidders; and


WHEREAS, Pro-Kill Pest Control has since submitted a Bid Guaranty complying with the provisions of the Instructions to Bidders; and

WHEREAS, this error did not result in prejudice to either the Authority or any other bidder; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that this contract be awarded to Pro-Kill Pest Control.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The bid of Pro-Kill Pest Control submitted on August 25, 1975 is hereby accepted and the Executive Director is authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the Authority the Contract contained in the Bid Documents.
