

RESOLUTION No. 220

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

May 5th, 1927

WHEREAS, Contract No. 10¹ of the City Council entered into with the Sacramento Bee of the City of Sacramento for the official advertising of all legal notices of the City of Sacramento for term of one year from date of May 1st, 1927, having been duly approved by said City Council on date of May 5th, 1927,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that the Sacramento Bee a daily newspaper published and circulated in the City of Sacramento, be and the same is hereby appointed and designated as the official newspaper of the City of Sacramento for a term of one year from date of May 1st, 1927, in accordance with provisions of foregoing Contract, in which said newspaper shall be published all official advertisements required by the Charter, City Ordinances or Resolutions and Statutes of the State of California, including the notices relative to filing of street assessments as provided by the "Improvement Act of 1911" approved April 7th, 1911, all notices relative to issuance of street improvement bonds as provided by "Improvement Bond Act of 1915", approved June 11th, 1915 and all notices required by Law to be published by the Superintendent of Streets.
