

RESOLUTION NO. 1043

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council on date of

November 24, 1939

RESOLUTION CANCELLING TAXES

WHEREAS, the application of the City of Sacramento for cancellation of the taxes upon the real property hereinafter described, now owned by said City, having been presented; and

WHEREAS, it appearing that, under and by virtue of Section 3804-a, Political Code, said taxes should be cancelled;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said taxes should be cancelled.

The real property upon which said taxes are so cancelled is situated in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and is described as follows:

Tract of Land bounded by Lands as follows:

N - 5th Ave. S - Line Approx. 500' from 14th Ave.
E - Westerly bounded by Ellis Survey & 65th St.
W - San Juan Acres

Approximately 48 acres except a strip 50' wide, extension of 11th Avenue.


The taxes hereinbefore referred to are hereby made to include: Current--First Installment 1939-40 City Taxes.
