

SPECIAL MEETING
SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL
DECEMBER 18, 1952

The Honorable City Council met in special session on this date at hour of 9:15 o'clock A. M. Mayor Geisreiter presiding and roll call was answered by the following members: Councilmen Bahnfleth, Cooledge, Geisreiter, Hendren, Macaulay, Nielsen, Sayre, Seymour, Wood.

Also present: City Attorney Glenn, City Controller Hoover, Water Superintendent Hoskinson, City Engineer Klaus, Assessor-Collector McKinley, Assistant City Engineer Fairbairn, Fire Chief Mulligan and several citizens were also present.

Executed copy of the call served by the City Clerk upon all members of the Council was ordered filed.

Call stated purpose of meeting to be that of considering the matter of Municipal services in the fringe areas and to also consider any other matter of official business regularly coming before said body. 1853

Representative Lloyd of the Fire Underwriters was present and also addressed the Council.

The City Manager presented the following report:

Members in Session:

The following data will, no doubt, give you some information concerning the request for fire protection from the American River Fire District.

Cost of fire protection to the taxpayers of Sacramento is \$1,125,325.72 per year, broken down as follows:

Budget for salaries and operational expense	\$909,098.00
Contributions-Fire Department Pension System	161,628.72
Medical expenses	8,890.00
Capital expenses--equipment (based on 20 year amortization)	45,709.00

The total County assessed valuation of all property--personal, real and public utilities--within the incorporated city limits is \$164,242,020.00.

Tax rate based on County valuation necessary to raise cost of fire protection - 69¢.

Valuation by Council of the American River Fire District is \$5,455,070.00.

The 69¢ rate cost to American River Fire District is \$37,639.98 per year.

Cost of fire protection in the City of Sacramento to California Packing Corporation is \$7,849.00 per year; to Libby, McNeil & Libby - \$3,573.70 per year; to American Can Company - \$9,595.00 per year; to Valley Wholesale Grocers - \$2,187.38 per year.

Mr. T. H. Richards of Bercut-Richards Company addressed Council concerning the report and his understanding of the provisions of the contract and services to be rendered by the City.

Fire Chief Connors of the American River Fire District also addressed Council concerning the services rendered by his district and its cooperation with the City of Sacramento.

The City Manager further reported as to response to calls across the river and the cost and results thereof to the City of Sacramento in certain cases.

After further discussion, Councilman Wood expressed in his opinion it was the sense of the Council that contracts cease on December 31, 1951 and that we function on a mutual aid basis in the future.
