

RESOLUTION NO: 177  
Adopted May 9th, 1929

WHEREAS, the Government of the United States expects to erect a Federal Building in the City of Sacramento in the near future, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento, by and through its City Council and Board of Education have tendered to the said Government of the United States the north one-half of the block bounded by I and J and 10th and 11th streets as and for a suitable site for said Federal Building, and

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the City Council of said City of Sacramento, in council assembled, that the said site so tendered possesses many supreme advantages and elements of desirability for such purpose, and

WHEREAS, among other reasons the selection of said half block for said purpose by the Federal Government and the location thereon of said Federal Building would complete the established scheme of a municipal civic center;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the said City Council of the City of Sacramento that the Treasury Department of said Government be earnestly and respectfully urged to carefully consider all of the advantages belonging to said tendered site;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Council, express its willingness to co-operate in every way toward the selection of said tendered property as and for the site of said Federal Building.
