

RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO DURING AMOUNT OF DEPOSIT TO BE MADE BY PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY IN CONNECTION WITH ITS APPLICATION TO SAID CITY COUNCIL FOR THE GRANT OF A FRANCHISE TO OPERATE MOTOR BUSES FOR TRANSPORTING PASSENGERS FOR COMPENSATION ALONG THE ROUTE THEREIN MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of California, has filed with this City Council its application bearing date, the 8th day of August, 1929, for the grant to it by said City Council of a franchise to operate motor buses for transporting passengers for compensation along the route therein more particularly described;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that said applicant be required to deposit with the City Treasurer of said city, either in cash or by certified check payable to said city, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) as a guarantee of the good faith of applicant and as a fund out of which to pay all expenses incurred by said city connected with said application, including the cost of publication in the event that the said franchise is awarded to applicant or be not awarded at all.
