

RESOLUTION No. 401

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Golden Empire Centennial has asked permission to use that portion of Southside Park extending from the entrance road near the tennis courts, south of X Street and all of the area generally south and west of the lake, and in addition the two blocks between X and Y and 6th and 8th Streets, including 7th Street between the two blocks, as a site for its celebration commemorating the One Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the City of Sacramento, and

WHEREAS, this use will be for a semi-public purpose,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

THAT said Sacramento Golden Empire Centennial be and it is hereby granted permission to use said areas for said purpose without charge, provided suitable guarantee is furnished that the City shall be held harmless from liability caused by such use and that the time for such occupancy shall be between November 15, 1938 and October 1, 1939.
