SUBJECT: Resolution Appropriating Funds and Recommendation of Bid Award
for Ellen Street Drainage Project

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends appropriation of funds and award of bid.

BACKGROUND:

This project was approved by the Budget and Finance Committee on November 3, 1980 and by the City Council on November 12, 1980. At that time, the Engineer's estimate project cost was \$34,100; however, it was recommended that the funding be appropriated following receipt of bids. Plans and specifications for the Ellen Street Drainage Project were approved by the City Council on June 23, 1981. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on July 14, 1981. Bids received are as follows:
