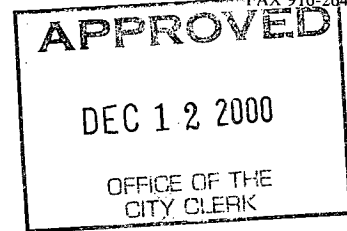

SUBJECT: ELEVATING NORTHGATE BOULEVARD PROJECT (PN:TG91) - APPROVAL OF ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$902,838 WITH HDR ENGINEERING , INC.

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Northgate Boulevard between State Route 160 and Arden-Garden Connector, Council District 1.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council authorize the City Manager to execute the attached Consultant Services Agreement in the amount of \$902,838 with HDR Engineering, Inc. for engineering services for Elevating Northgate Boulevard between State Route 160 and Arden-Garden Connector.

SUMMARY:

This report requests that the City Council authorize and direct the City Manager to execute a Consultant Services Agreement with HDR Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$902,838 for engineering design services for Elevating Northgate Boulevard Project.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Staff has completed the consultant selection process for engineering consulting services. A Request for Proposal (RFP) for the Elevating Northgate Boulevard Project was advertised and five (5) firms responded. The consultant selection panel was composed of representatives from the City Technical Services and City Planning Department. The panel reviewed and rated the written proposals and conducted an interview with three firms. HDR Engineering, Inc. has assembled a highly qualified and experienced team to perform the engineering services needed for the project. HDR Engineering, Inc. was ranked the highest and was chosen for this project.

The panel scored the written proposals and the interview utilizing the following evaluation criteria:

- Introduction & Experience
- Qualifications of the firm, project team, and assigned personnel
- Workplan
- ESBE Utilization

Overall firm rankings were based on the combined total of points received on the written proposal and the interview.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

HDR Engineering, Inc. will prepare the project EIR/EIS for certification by City Council.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The proposed project cost for consultant services is \$902,838. Local funds (Measure A) in the amount of \$1,102,389 have been allocated to the project for the design phase, which is sufficient to approve the agreement with the HDR Engineering, Inc. Staff will return to Council at a future date for approval of the Program Supplement and additional Local, State and Federal funds for the construction phase of the project.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This action is consistent with the existing City policy concerning consultant selection and consultant services agreements.


