SUBJECT: Approval of Application for Energy Conservation
Funds to Aid Communities from the California
Energy Extension Service

SUMMARY

Attached is a resolution whereby the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento approves an application to the California Energy Extension Service (CEES) for a Community Energy Program. This program is to provide funding and technical assistance to organizations at the local level who will perform services aimed at improving the use of available energy. The amount requested from CEES is \$40,000.

BACKGROUND

The California Energy Extension Service, an affiliate of the Office of Appropriate Technology, is accepting applications, due on March 14, 1980, to provide funding and technical assistance to persons or organizations at the local level who will perform services aimed at improving the use of available energy. The objective of the program is to provide educational programs to energy users to adopt energy conserving measures where they live and/or work. This application for the Community Energy Program meets the eligibility requirements under the category of projects, particularly the Tenant/Apartment-Owner Program.

The Community Energy Program is looking for proposals from tenant and/or landlord groups concerned with energy efficiency in rental housing. This application is proposing to use the available funds in two categories:

1. In-house training program for SHRA personnel. The training sessions will include lectures, manuals,

films and workshops. The training sessions will be video-taped and be available for ongoing training of new SHRA Staff and used by other similar agencies.

2. Tenant training program. Selected apartment units (New Helvetia and River Oaks) will be analyzed for a demonstration of energy saving methods. Meetings will be held with resident committees and tenants to set up workshops and literature distributed to convey energy saving concepts.

FINANCIAL DATA

The amount requested from the California Energy Extension Service is \$40,000. No new personnel or other funds are needed.


