SUBJECT: An interim ordinance restricting demolition or relocation of potentially historic buildings in the Central City constructed prior to January 1, 1950 (M00-045)

LOCATION: Central City Community Plan Area (Districts 1, 3 and 4)

RECOMMENDATION:

Planning staff recommends that the City Council approve the attached interim ordinance which will restrict the demolition and relocation of potentially historic buildings. The ordinance will apply to all buildings and structures located within the Central City and constructed prior to January 1, 1950.

SUMMARY:

The City of Sacramento's current Official Register listing historic structures is the result of an inventory adopted by the City Council in 1985. Since that time, preservation volunteers have worked on a "study list" of structures in an attempt to update the Official Register; however, an official survey has not been conducted, reviewed and approved by the Design Review/Preservation Board (DRPB) and City Council. Since 1995, structures on the study list prepared by volunteers have been demolished for various reasons.
