

# RESOLUTION No. 431

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, M. J. Dillman conveyed by deed dated March 3 1891, recorded March 4 1891 in Book 109 of deeds, page 55, Sacramento County Records, a right of way upon which to dig and construct a ditch for surface drainage purposes and which right of way is particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 60 links West of the center line of the upper Stockton Road on the South line of the Sutter Grant and on the North line of Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 5 East, M.D.B. & M. running thence along said line 35 links; thence South 1° East 17 chains 1 link to a point 3 links South of the South line of Magnolia Avenue running thence West 12 chains 95 links to the intersection line of the lands of M. J. Dillman and South Sacramento, and to be at least 5 feet in width over its entire course or distance, and

WHEREAS, said description is in error in that said right of way is in Township 8 and not Township 3, and

WHEREAS, the County of Sacramento has conveyed said right of way to the City of Sacramento, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has taken over the matter of drainage within its limits and installed sewers and said right of way is no longer necessary or can be used,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said right of way be, and the same is hereby, abandoned and vacated.
