**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A HUMANITIES  
COLLECTIONS AND RESOURCES GRANT FROM THE NATIONAL  
ENDOWMENT FOR THE HUMANITIES**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. The National Endowment for the Humanities Collections and Resources grant is a two-year competitive grant for state and local jurisdictions, tribal governments and nonprofit organizations.
- B. The award amounts range from \$50,000 to \$350,000 with no requirement for matching City funds. The deadline to apply is July 17, 2007.

RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The History and Science Division of the Convention, Culture and Leisure Department is authorized to apply for a Humanities Collections and Resources grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities.


